Total possible income

£600 sponsorship (12 x £50) + £1000 sales (200x£5) would give us £1,600

£1,600 - £836.40 = £763.6 total potential profit

We might want to consider putting up the price to £6 as printing costs have risen for the second year running.

Summer Programme

The summer programme is an initiative spread across two of Hamworthy's greenspaces, (Hamworthy Park and Bluebell Woods) and is a continuation of the successful Easter activity programme run during the Easter break.

Half of the programme (forest school sessions) is funded by Dorset Community Foundation via a grant to FOHP. The Trustees agreed to spend £300 on 2 beach school sessions in the park as part of the programme.

It is a trial and, if successful, we would aim to have the programme fully funded by grant for next year.

FOHP already has a strong tradition of "giving back" to the community, most notably at the Easter egg hunt.
